- Position Summary:** Supports EC by delivering and implementing its community health program strategies and activities.
- License Requirements:** Valid NM or TX Class D driver’s license. Must be insurable.
- Education:** High school diploma/GED and/or NM DOH Community Health Worker Certification.
- Experience:** One - three years of experience working as a community health worker, public health campaigns, outreach campaigns, non-profit organizations and/or grassroots initiatives preferred.
- Skills/Abilities:** Bilingual English/Spanish **required**; self-motivating, with general supervision by the CHW Program Manager; Ability to work with people from all cultural and economic backgrounds of all ages in a friendly and congenial manner; strong interpersonal skills with community; familiarity with community organizing in rural, low-income, at-risk communities; Knowledge of community outreach and education, community networking, with strong written, oral, organizational and data entry skills; small administrative tasks as needed; Knowledge of Microsoft Office, Google Workspace, online databases, project management tools and social media platforms. If limited experience or knowledge with the above skills, should be willing to learn.
- Job Duties:** CHW will conduct behavioral and mental health outreach education and advocacy to Dona Ana County community members and their families, in assigned county areas. CHW will find creative ways to increase mental and behavioral health services acceptance and assist clients in obtaining services. CHW will identify and recruit community members to attend community workshops, trainings and events. CHW will provide social support by listening to concerns of the community members and their families. CHW will engage in case management, supporting community members’ enrollment, appointments, and referrals to other service providers. CHW will attend and be involved in local community coalitions, committees, and workgroups, as assigned. CHW will organize, support and facilitate community workshops, trainings and events. Promote community awareness of the EC, SUCCESS! Partnership and CAASNМ’s mission, services and programs, other related duties as assigned; Must be able to pass a background check.
